Winners receive recognition at the NE WA Fair and the County Awards Banquet. The experienced leader will also be recognized at the State 4-H Forum held in October. A nomination form is enclosed with this mailing.

August 8—4-H Horse Program Meeting. All 4-H horse project leaders and members are invited to the horse program meetings. Today's meeting will be start at 6 p.m. at the extension office.
