Your participation in **4-H** activities carries the responsibility of representing Stevens County **4-H** to the public. 1. Participants will demonstrate respect and courtesy to everyone present.
2. Dress appropriate to the occasion. At all times be courteous, clean and display good manners. Language must be appropriate and respectful of others. Swearing is NOT considered appropriate.
3. You are expected to be a participant at program events and responsible to adult chaperones and leaders. Inform your chaperone of illness, conflicts or any reason you must leave the group.
4. Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or any controlled substance (other than prescribed medicine) is strictly prohibited. Participants may NOT use tobacco products.
5. Criminal law violations (including, without limitations, shoplifting, theft, drug possession, under-age tobacco use or under-age drinking) will not be tolerated.
6. Avoid roughness and damage to other's property. Participants are financially responsible for any damage or misconduct.
7. Public displays of affections will be monitored by chaperones. Please keep displays of affection appropriate to a 4-H event.
